

Terrie Sullivan's Pictorial Guide To Building A Grooming Table

**A photo of a simple groom table.
It's made out of plywood & 1 x 2 inch thick legs.**



Table w/o top

here are just the legs of the table. Two pieces of nylon material keep the legs from opening too far. The legs are 36 inches long, and are spaced 17 inches apart.



Underside of tabletop

Here is the underside of the tabletop. The two pieces of wood screwed to the bottom keep the top from sliding around while on the legs.



Underside of Table

Here the top has been set on to the legs. The table fits snugly between the two dowel rods, which prevent it from moving around.



Top View

Here is the top view of the table. The top measures 22 x 22 x 3 1/2 inches. The storage area in the back is 5 inches x 22 inches. The front of the table is tapered to 1 1/2 inches in height.



The finished product



measurements

4 Legs

36 inches long
spaced 17 inches apart.

1 Top

22 x 22 x 3 inches. The front is
only 1 1/2 inches high and the
storage area is 5 inches deep.

2 Doll Rods

1 inch thick, connect the
legs together.

2 Straps

20 inches long keep the legs
from opening too far.
